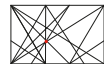

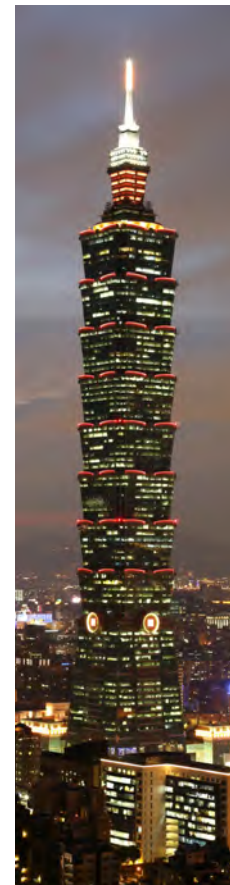

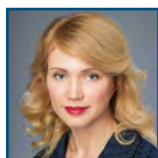

**AVOIDING MISTAKES IN INJECTABLE FILLERS**

Understanding how to avoid mistakes when performing aesthetic procedures is a must for any practitioner. 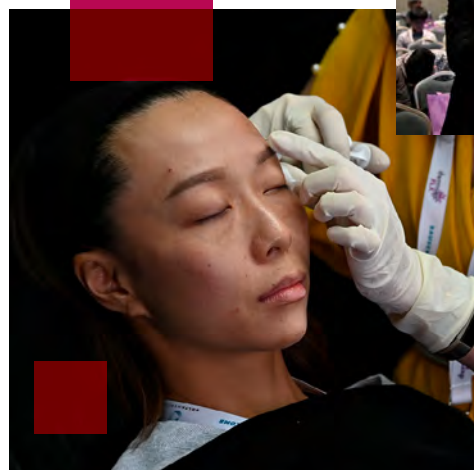
